1. Animals adopted from A Place for Peanut, Inc. include no guarantees regarding soundness, temperament, or general condition. Adopter recognizes and agrees to hold harmless APFP, its directors, officers, heirs, or assigns forever for any damage or injury to property or persons.
2. APFP has had the opportunity to observe the interaction between the adopter and the equine and has determined that this adoption is in the best interest for all parties involved.
3. APFP may visit the equine on a regular basis during the first six months to insure that the equine is properly cared for.



4. The adopter agrees to notify APFP at least two weeks prior to the intended relocation of the equine, in order to assure a smooth transition for the equine, the herd and all humans involved. The adopter also agrees to provide APFP with information on the location of the adopted equine at all times.
6. Should there be any evidence that the adopted equine is not cared for properly or treated inhumanly or used for activity the equine is not properly trained or fit or healthy for APFP will have the right to reclaim said animal.
5. In the event that the equine is no longer wanted by the adopter or the adopter believes that he or she can no longer provide adequate care for said equine, for any reason, under any circumstance, including illness and/or death of the adopter, the equine must be returned APFP. The equine **cannot** be sold or sent to auction or slaughter.
6. Buy Back Option: APFP withholds and retains the right to buy back the equine if the purchaser decides to sell for price sold for.
7. If adopting a stud, I agree to have said equine gelded. I will notify APFP with a copy of my veterinarians' receipt stating the procedure has been done. APFP has the right to contact the adoptees vet and if the stud has not been gelded in a reasonable amount of time, APFP has the right to confiscate the equine at the adopter's expense.

Both parties consider this adoption final and binding.
